Divisions 3, 5, and 6 learned about Bike Safety and had a chance to practice these skills on our field.

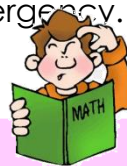
The PAC held a family Games Night on the 19th. Thanks to all the families that joined us and to PAC for hosting another fun family event.

- What do you know about this part?

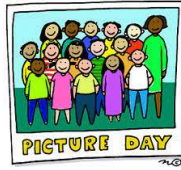
SCHOOL NEWS






The Lost & Found bin will be setup outside the main office on **Tuesday, May 14th** during Student-Led Conferences. Please have a look to see if your child has lost anything.
